Summary of Experience

Experienced school district administrator, school psychologist, and adjunct faculty serving in public education since 2003. I currently work at the Oregon Department of Education as a Coordinator of an investigation unit responding to complaints of sexual misconduct of school staff. I have served as a school psychologist, assistant principal, special education administrator, director of student services for rural and urban school districts, and adjunct faculty at Portland State University.
